



Newbury Jr./Sr. High School Athletic Department Competition Transportation Policy

Students will ride to and from athletic contests on school provided transportation. Exception: school events that are in conflict with athletic contests. To be excused from riding school transportation to attend a school event, a student must bring a note signed by a parent PRIOR to the contest. That student ONLY may be released to his/her parent.

All other requests for release from transportation on school vehicles must be given for athletic department approval to the coach three days prior to such conflict.
