

FEDERAL FUNDS – TITLE I PARENT INFORMATION

At the beginning of each school year, the district will hold a meeting for parents to invite their involvement in decisions about how Federal monies are to be spent to improve the achievement of students and to insure that parents are involved in Title I services. Once the beginning of the year meeting date has been set, it will be published on the website, announced in Board of Education Meetings, and included on the district information board in front of the school.

This year, there will also be a meeting to encourage parent involvement in Title I services on Monday, April 13, 2015, at 5:30 PM in the high school band room immediately preceding the regular April Board of Education Meeting. Parents are invited to attend.

Parents always have the right to request and receive information regarding the professional qualifications of students' classroom teachers, including the following:

- **Whether the teacher has met state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas taught,**
- **Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or temporary status in which State qualifications or licensing criteria are waived,**
- **The teacher' baccalaureate degree major, graduate certification, field of discipline, and**
- **Whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.**

Upon request to the Superintendent, reasonable accommodations will be provided to parents with disabilities in order to allow them to participate in these meetings.
